

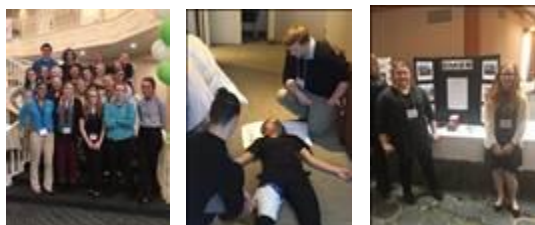
Health Science May News
