



The Community Health Care Center is pleased to offer medical and behavioral health services to Great Falls Public School students, their families and staff. School-Based Health Centers are small clinics that are located on school property. There are clinics located at Paris Gibson Education Center at 2400 Central Avenue and Giant Springs Elementary at 520 32nd St N.

What services does the School-Based Clinic offer?

- Routine well child check-ups with immunizations
- Physical exams/sports physicals
- Urgent care
- Management of chronic illnesses such as diabetes or asthma
- Laboratory testing
- Well-women exams

Who can use the School-based clinic?

- The clinic at Paris Gibson Education Center is open to all students enrolled in the Great Falls Public Schools, their families and staff of Great Falls Public Schools
- The clinic at Giant Springs Elementary is open to Giant Springs students and GFPS staff

When is the School-Based Clinic open?

- The clinic at Paris Gibson Education Center is open on Mondays from 7:30AM-4:30PM and Wednesdays from 9AM-6PM
- The clinic at Giant Springs is open on Thursdays from 7:30AM-4:30PM

Is there a charge for the School-Based Clinic's services?

- The School-Based Clinic accepts Medicare, Medicaid, Healthy Montana Kids and most insurance plans. If you have insurance, we will bill directly to your insurance company. You will be responsible for co-pays and any unmet deductible amounts. For both those with or without insurance, we offer sliding fee scale that is based on income and family size. No child will be denied services due to the inability to pay.

In order for students to receive services at the School-Based Health Center, a complete and signed consent form needs to be returned to the School-Based Health Center. The consent must be on file prior to the child being seen.
